We cordially invite you to the workshop on information standards and dictionaries that will be held on 20-21 November 2008, in Brussels.

The workshop is organised by two of the Europe INNOVA Standards Networks (INNOVAFUN and DEPUIS) in cooperation with the CEN/ISSS Focus Group CDC (Interoperability of computer sensible product dictionary and classification).

Objectives

The workshop focuses on bringing together experts and business managers from various sectors to share information about the application of information standards and to define shared interests and requirements.

The workshop will also demonstrate with practical examples the role of data dictionaries in the data exchange business processes and transactions. It will also show how information standards are a valuable tool to support innovation.

Participants

The workshop aims at company staff processing information and data coming from different sources and experiences directly the interoperability problem.

Therefore you will be able to network with your peers involved in the exchange of product / plant information exchange between companies in sectors such as Process & Power e.g. Oil, Gas, Chemicals, Pulp & Paper, Pharmaceuticals, Shipbuilding, Civil & Construction, Manufacturing industries e.g. Furniture, Electrical equipment industries, Automotive, Aerospace. Solution and knowledge providers to these industries will be present.

We would like you to contribute by stating your ideas and requirements with respect to the themes of this workshop. Should you be interested you will be able to forward and present your idea in a 5-minute presentation at the workshop. After your registration you will receive a template on this purpose.

Programme

The main theme of the workshop will be technical data and information storage and exchange of products / plant installations in companies and between companies. The focus will be on standardisation of product / plant data and information to achieve interoperability between companies. A dedicated role is given to business processes, transactions and the role of product data dictionaries to support those. Details are given in the agenda.

Route description

METRO

You should take metro line 1 and get off at Schuman, the nearest metro stop. (It is only a 2 minutes' walk from the office building)

BUS

The buses 12, 21, 22, 28 and 36 all stop at the Schuman square, which is very near the office of the Delegation. Bus 12 is a regular line that provides transport from and to Brussels National Airport (Zaventem) www.stib.be

Access from the AROPORT and the RAILWAY STATION

The railway station at the airport, which can be found on -1, provides a direct connection to the city of Brussels. Trains leave every 15 minutes and the journey takes about 25 minutes. The Airport City Express runs daily from 6 o'clock until midnight, four times per hour, and stops at Brussels North, Central and Midi. A one-way ticket costs 2.40€ (second class) or 3.70€ (first class). At the railway station Central you can change to metro lines 1A and 1B.

There is also a bus service available from the airport: bus line 12. A ticket costs 3€ and there are buses every half an hour. The bus leaves you at the Schuman square, the roundabout near our office.

A taxi from the airport costs approximately 30€. There are also other kinds of taxi services available such as www.autolux.be. This company offers a 20% -reduction on a return ticket from the airport. At the first journey it is necessary to fill in a form in order to apply for the reduction. This fare is valid during a period of two months and it is necessary to specify this at beginning of the trip.
